

## Auckland Unitary Plan Regional Coastal Plan – Operative in Part

The regional coastal plan provisions of the Auckland Unitary Plan were prepared by the Auckland Council under section 64 of the Resource Management Act 1991 and section 122 of the Local Government (Auckland Transitional Provisions) Act 2010.

The Auckland Council adopted the regional coastal plan provisions of the Proposed Auckland Unitary Plan (that are not subject to challenge) for reference to the Minister of Conservation on 29 September 2016.

The Minister required the Council to make various amendments to the regional coastal plan provisions pursuant to clause 19(1) of Schedule 1 to the Resource Management Act 1991 by letter dated 16 April 2018. Those amendments have been incorporated into the regional coastal plan provisions.
