### 1. Activity table

#### 2. Land use controls

#### 2.1 Temporary activities

1. The temporary activity development controls in clause 6.5.2 of the Auckland-wide rules - General section do not apply in the Auckland Zoo and MOTAT precinct.

#### 3. Development controls

- The development controls in the Major Recreation Facility zone shall apply in the Zoo and MOTAT precinct.
- 2. The temporary activity development controls at clause 4.2.5.5.2 shall not apply in the Auckland Zoo and MOTAT precinct.

#### 3.1 Noise

The noise generated by any activity as measured at or within the boundary of any site comprising a Noise Sensitive Land Use or at the notional boundary of any Noise Sensitive Land Use in the Rural zone shall not exceed the following noise limits:
